 - Original H.S.C. Examination Mark statement along with its two Photocopies,
 - Photocopy of the Leaving Certificate,
 - Duly filled in Identity Card Slip with recent Passport size photographs affixed on it.
 - Photocopy of Caste Certificate from competent authority in case of students belonging to Reserve category.

Students are advised to keep adequate attested photocopies of Original H.S.C. Mark statement and Leaving certificate before its submission.

- 4. At the time of Admission, students should produce Originals of S.S.C. Examination Mark statement and Caste Certificate (if applicable) for verification.
- 5. The timings for Admission and payment of Fees will be from 10.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.
- 6. Fees will be accepted in Cash, Cheque or Demand Draft payable at Mumbai. Cheques/Demand Drafts should be drawn in favour of **Principal**, **D. G. Ruparel College**.
- 7. Every student must collect his/her Leaving Certificate as per the schedule displayed by the College Office.
